Suffolk Plastic Surgeons PC is committed to the health and safety of our patients and staff. While our office is currently open, we are asking for your assistance; any patient who has a scheduled appointment or surgery and currently has, or has had, within the last 14 days, the following symptoms, please contact our office prior to your appointment: fever, cough, difficulty breathing or runny nose. Any patient exhibiting the above, will need to be rescheduled. Please do not come to the office, as you will not be seen. This protocol is being implemented for the benefit of all.

What is Suffolk Plastic Surgeons PC doing to protect patients and staff?

- **We have placed extra hand sanitizing areas around the office**
- **All areas of our practice are being cleaned and sanitized during office hours and in- between appointments. This is in addition to our normal cleaning schedule.**
- **Restricting patients who are exhibiting symptoms from entering our office & having them reschedule their appointments for a later date**
- **Patients who have an appointment and are not symptomatic are being asked to check in, then wait in their vehicle until we call them in.**
- **Increased all appointments by 5 minutes to allow patients time to enter & exit our facility**

Help Keep Our Community Healthy!

The wellbeing of our patients and staff is our top priority. The CDC recommends the following precautionary measures to keep you healthy and prevent the spread of COVID-19:

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
Use an alcohol-based sanitizer when soap and water are not available
